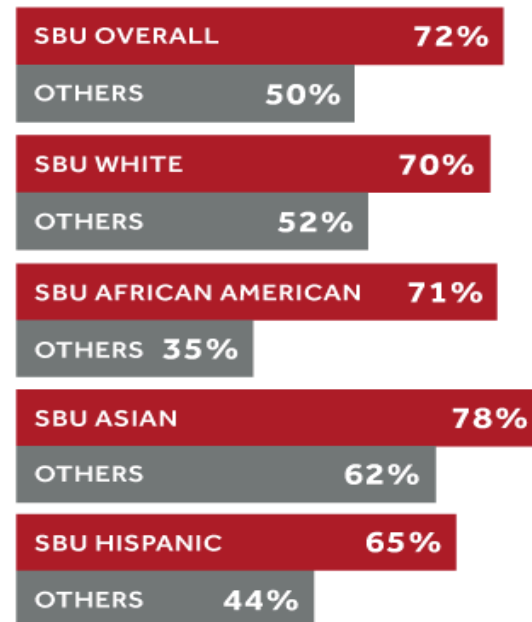

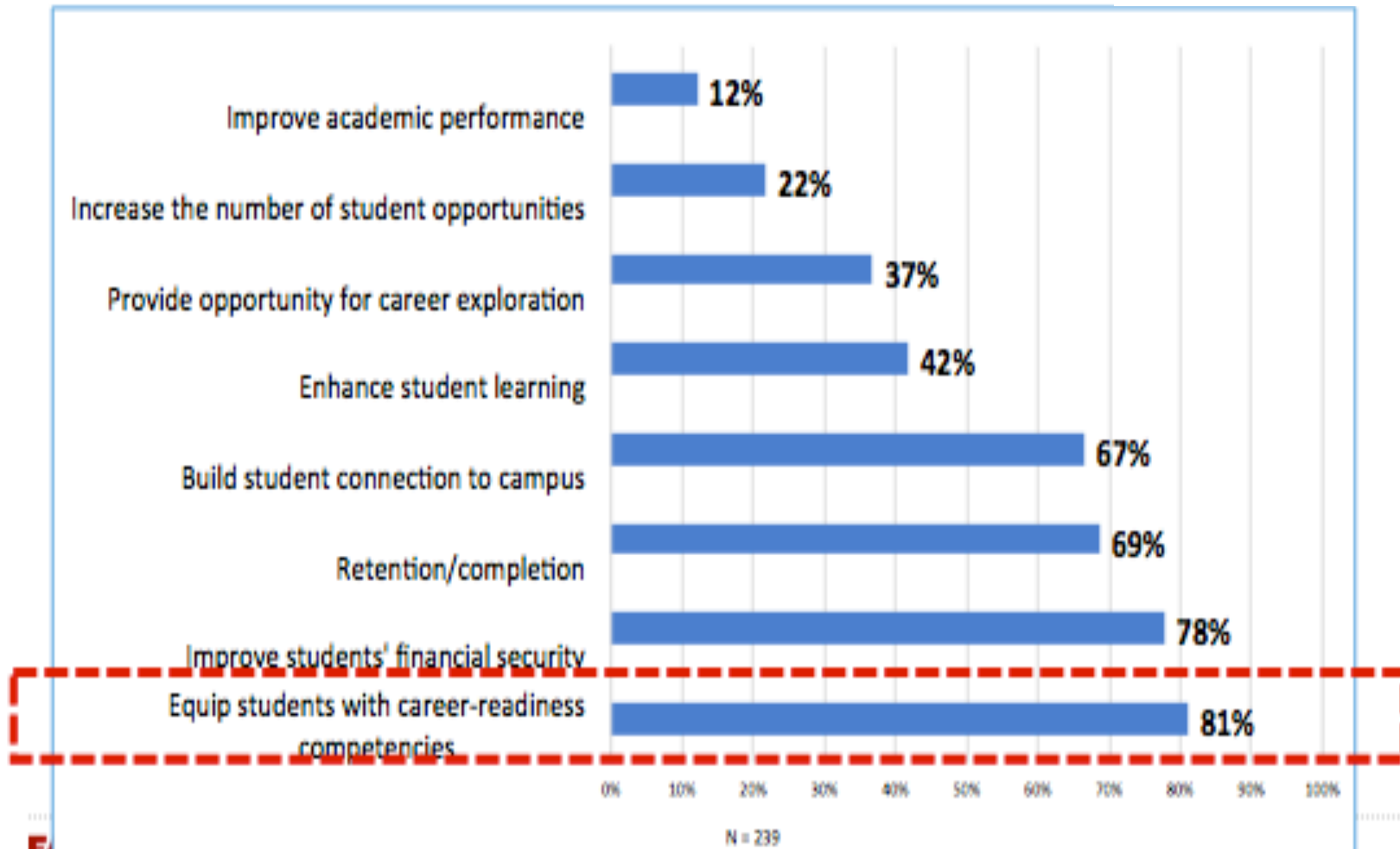
Employers rated proficiency vs. students rated proficiency

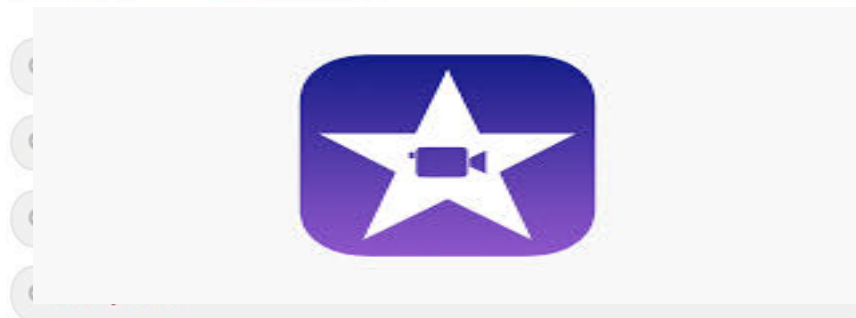

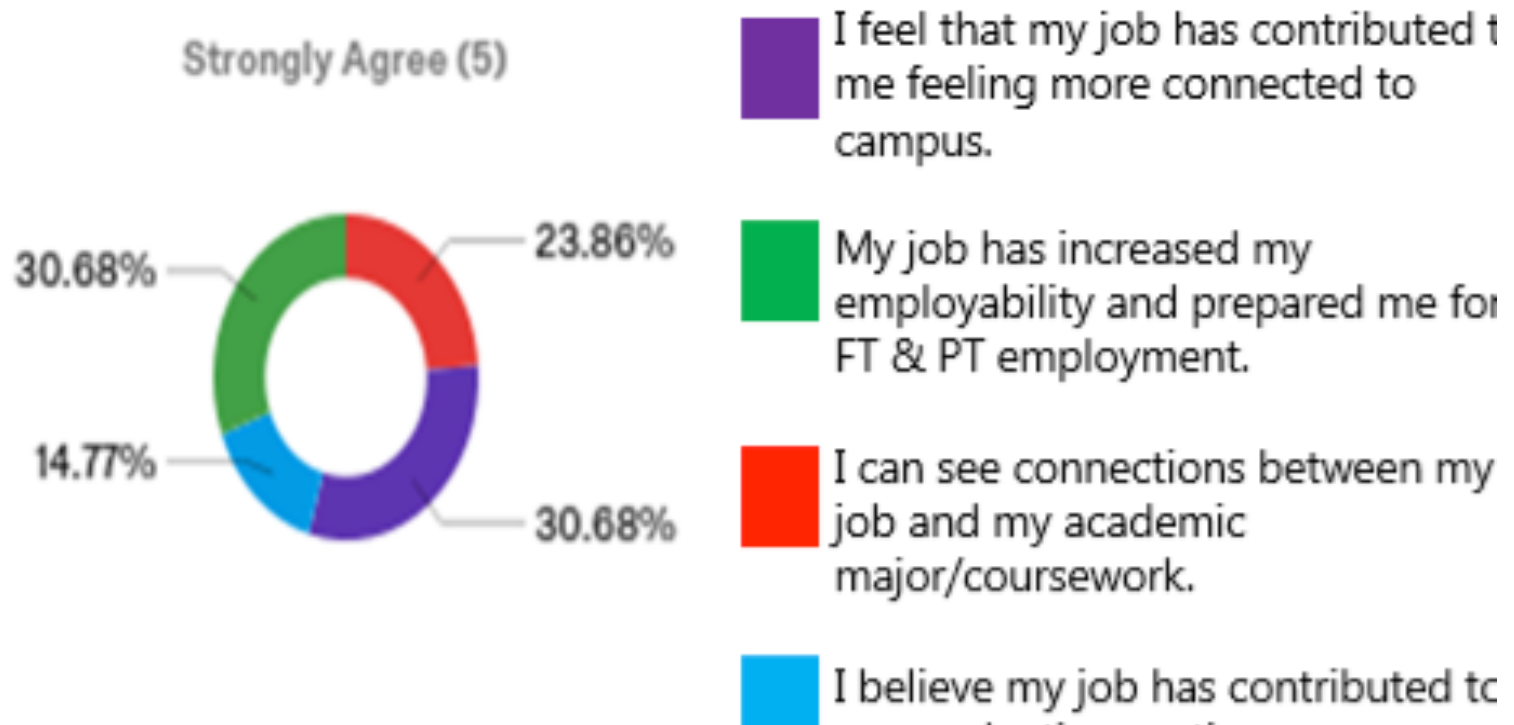
