Director, Nuclear Power Institute

Professor of Nuclear Engineering, Texas A&M University

Kenneth L. Peddicord is Director of the Nuclear Power Institute (NPI) and Professor of Nuclear Engineering at Texas A&M University.

He received the B.S. degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Notre Dame, and the M.S. and Ph.D. in Nuclear Engineering from the University of Illinois.



From 1972 to 1975, he was a Research Nuclear Engineer at the Eidgenössisches Institut für Reaktorforschung (the Swiss Federal Institute for Reactor Research), now the Paul Scherrer Institut, in Würenlingen, Switzerland.

From 1975 to 1981, Dr. Peddicord was Assistant Professor and Associate Professor of Nuclear Engineering at Oregon State University, and in 1981-82, he was as a Visiting Scientist at the EURATOM Joint Research Centre in Ispra, Italy.

In 1983, he joined the faculty of Texas A&M University as Professor of Nuclear Engineering and has served in a number of administrative roles. From 2007 to 2019, he was director of the Nuclear Power Institute. NPI is a partnership with a focus to inform, attract and prepare students for all facets of the technical workforce for the nuclear industry and develop public understanding and acceptance of nuclear energy.
