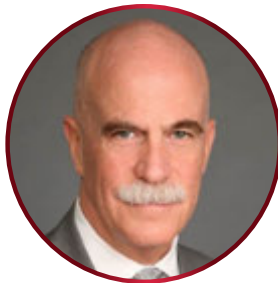

SUPPLY CHAIN RISK MANAGEMENT AND CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE RESILIENCE

Collaboration across the private and public sectors is crucial to homeland security. This is particularly true for achieving supply chain and critical infrastructure resilience. Over the last two years, the Administration and the Congress have taken considerable steps to make these issues a priority and to align policy and investments to manage risks while balancing overlapping priorities of homeland security, economic security, economic competitiveness, and innovation. This breakout session will discuss the most significant geopolitical, technological, and economic risks to resilient supply chains and critical infrastructure and how the homeland security enterprise should address them. It will also lay out a vision for how economic security and homeland security are related and talk through the policy, doctrinal and governance implications for that imperative. A key objective of the discussion is to develop further ideas on how the public and private sector can be incentivized for additional investments in resilience.
