Tom Sanderson is a consultant and the co-founder and former director of the Transnational Threats Project at CSIS where he conducted field work across 75 countries, engaging NGOs, terrorists, refugees, intelligence officials, and clergy. Over 25 years of counterterrorism and geopolitical research, Sanderson produced dozens of reports and published multiple op-eds in The New York Times and Washington Post.

Tom testifies before the U.S. Congress, provides expert commentary for the media, and teaches for the U.S. Intelligence Community.

Sanderson is Principal at Tom Sanderson Consulting, LLC, leading a multinational geopolitical risk team in service to public and private sector clients. From 1998–2002, he conducted several studies for the IC. Tom held fellowships at the American Academy in Berlin and at Fudan University in Shanghai. Sanderson holds a B.A. and an Honorary Doctor of Laws from Wheaton College in Massachusetts and an M.A. from the Fletcher School at Tufts University.
