Dr. Vasilis Valdramidis (Male) is an Associate Prof at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (Department of Chemistry) and visiting Associate Prof at the University of Malta. He holds a Ph.D degree in Chemical Engineering from the Catholic University of Leuven, Belgium and a primary degree in Agriculture (Food Science and Technology) from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece). He is active in the disciplines of quantitative microbiology, food safety and food preservation. He is treasurer of the International Committee on Food Microbiology and Hygiene and member of the International Commission of Food Mycology, while he is currently in the editorial boards of International Journal of Food Microbiology, and Journal of Food Protection.
