

Biography Dr. Maarten Nauta (MSc, Phd):

Dr. Nauta is employed as Senior Researcher at the department of Infectious Disease Epidemiology and Infection of Statens Serum Institut. Educated as mathematical biologist, he previously worked at the National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM) in the Netherlands and the National Food Institute of the Technical University of Denmark (DTU), where he, among others, specialised in quantitative microbiological risk assessment and the development of methods for "farm to fork" risk assessments. He is the (co-) author of more than 100 scientific publications in international peer reviewed journals (h-index 41). Next to advisory work, he gave courses in risk assessment at University and for Food Safety professionals all over the world, and supervised Master students, PhD students and post-docs. Since 2015 he is Associate Editor of the journal Microbial Risk Analysis (Co-Editor in Chief since 2020); since 2017 he is elected as member of the International Committee of Predictive Modelling in Foods; since 2018 he is member of the EFSA BIOHAZ panel.
