His research focuses on early recognition, treatment and long-term outcomes of spondyloarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis with special interest in innovative analytical methods. Dr. Sepriano is a member of the EULAR's Quality of Care committee, member of the EULAR Research subcommittee for Epidemiology and Health Services Research and member of the expert panel of the EULAR Virtual Research Center. He has been involved in the development of EULAR recommendations for the management of patients with axial spondyloarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis. Dr. Sepriano is the editor in chief of ARP Rheumatology, the official journal of the Portuguese Society of Rheumatology.
