INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION, WHAT IS IT?

- Michael Byers: "ongoing yet often fluctuating process: it can start, stop, and start again"
- "The act of nations and peoples working together to
 - achieve common goals,
 - solve global problems, and
 - promote mutual understanding and prosperity."
- The goal in planetary defense is
 - to agree planetary defense is a global effort
 - to figure out how to do it properly
 - to ensure predictable decision making

... done ... amazingly ongoing ... <mark>job to be done</mark>

- = defending planet
- = how to achieve it
- = <u>how to sustain it</u>

INTERNATIONAL SECURITY REGIME, WHAT IS IT?

A set of principles, norms, rules, and decision-making

procedures around which actors' expectations converge in a given area of international relations

Classic definition by Stephen Krasner

Regimes could spontaneously emerge through ongoing practices as *implicit* and become codified as *explicit*

BUILDING EXPLICIT MULTILATERAL SECURITY REGIME

Muiltilateral principles:

- **Principle of Indivisibility** > equal assurance of security regardless of the members' contribution
- **Principle of Diffuse Reciprocity** > each member contributes with its capabilities

all parties benefit from a stable and cooperative international system, and actions taken by one state to promote this system will ultimately benefit all regardless of the contribution

Under- standing	Epistemic communities have informal relations and understand their goals.	Protocols	States are ensured what protocols will be executed in case various scenarios materialize.
politics depends on INFORMAL MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING		politics depends on CONFIDENTIALITY and TRANSPARENCY	

These are only illustrative examples to explain the argument, the final shape could today already by significantly more complex

ADVANTAGES OF EXPLICIT MULTILATERAL PD REGIME

- Regimes could be achieved by *practices* and sustained by formal *accords/treaties – implicit PD regime* is already materializing, explicit ensures the goals
- Decisions of states are predictable, cooperative and some are made in advance
- Security sensitive technologies have protocols for their usage (NEDs)
- Even autocratic states feel more secure and can cause less damage
- All involved are covered by the security measures they all provide
- Science of PD can be sustainably funded because it has a political backing

Cooperation is predictable, sustainable, and filled with mutual confidence
