A dual track path is offered for conference contributions:

Full submission for IEEE publication. paper Submitted describe papers, that original contributions in the related fields, will be subjected to a peer reviewed process. The papers should not exceed four pages (references on page 5 is allowed). Papers should be submitted as pdf files prepared according to IEEE two-column A4 format guidelines; the full paper template is available here. The deadline for the full paper submission is the 28th of June (at 23:59 CET), and authors will be notified by 31st of August. Upon acceptance of notification, authors will be asked to submit an IEEE compliant final paper by 23rd of October for which instructions will be provided. Accepted and presented papers will be published in IEEE Xplore.

Abstract submission for conference proceedings only. In parallel it is also possible to present and publish work in the conference proceedings only, not with IEEE Xplore. The abstracts should be submitted in the relevant topics as on a single column abstract of 800-1000 words in length (a maximum of two figures per abstract is allowed). The deadline for the abstract submission is the 28th of June (at 23:59 CET), and authors will be notified by 31st of August. Accepted abstracts should be presented in oral sessions during the conference.
