# **Hygiene and Protective Measures**

## New coronavirus rules as of 3 April 2022

With the new coronavirus rules, far-reaching protective measures for which there is no longer a legal basis due to the new Federal Infection Protection Act will no longer apply in Baden-Württemberg as of Sunday, April 3, 2022.

- The Baden-Wuerttemberg Ordinance of the State Government on Infection Protection
  Measures against the Spread of the SARS-CoV-2 Virus (Corona Ordinance "CoronaVO")
  1 of 1 April 2022, (in the version valid from 31 May 2022) will now apply
- In addition, protection and hygiene measures may laid down by the organiser ESA, must be observed by all participants of FAR 2022.

#### **SAFETY & HYGIENE MEASURES**

All participants of the FAR 2022 must comply with the Corona Hygiene and Protection rules of the ESA organizer

Entering the FAR 2022 Venue Bildungscampus with Corona-typical disease symptoms is prohibited.

For regular disinfection, disinfectant dispensers are available for you throughout the building.

The conference rooms are also equipped with ventilation systems so that constant air circulation is guaranteed.

Also regular ventilation of all areas with fresh air by open doors/



## **FACE MASK PROTECTION**


A face mask that covers your mouth and nose must be worn:

- all days inside all conference rooms FAR 2022 at the Venue Bildungscampus
- In the "Dome", where we will broadcasting the movie Capcom Go! (Experimenta)
- in the bus to the DLR site (Technical Tour, on June 23, 2022) FFP2 masks are required to wear also at the test facilities at DLR site Lampolshausen.

There is no general obligation to wear a mask in the public areas of the venue .For your personal protection, however, we recommend that you wear a mask on indoor circulation areas, for your own protection and for the protection of all other participants

If you have forgotten your own face mask, a replacement will be waiting for you at the registration desk. We will masks and Corona testkits on stock.

All our staff on site are also instructed to wear face masks.

# WHAT RULES DO I HAVE TO FOLLOW AS A PARTICIPANT?

- Carry your own mouth-nose protective mask and please wear it all conference rooms
- Feel free to continue wearing a mask in the public areas of the venue
- Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly
- No shaking hands and no hugs
- Sneeze into the crook of your arm, avoid facing anyone or anything.
- Dispose of personal waste yourself.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE IS A SUDDEN CASE OF ILLNESS?

In the unlikely event of a recognisable suspected infection of a person with COVID-19, there is a tested action plan:

- The person is sent directly home.
- In case of an emergency (if not able to act/drive, etc.), an ambulance is called and the person is isolated until then.
