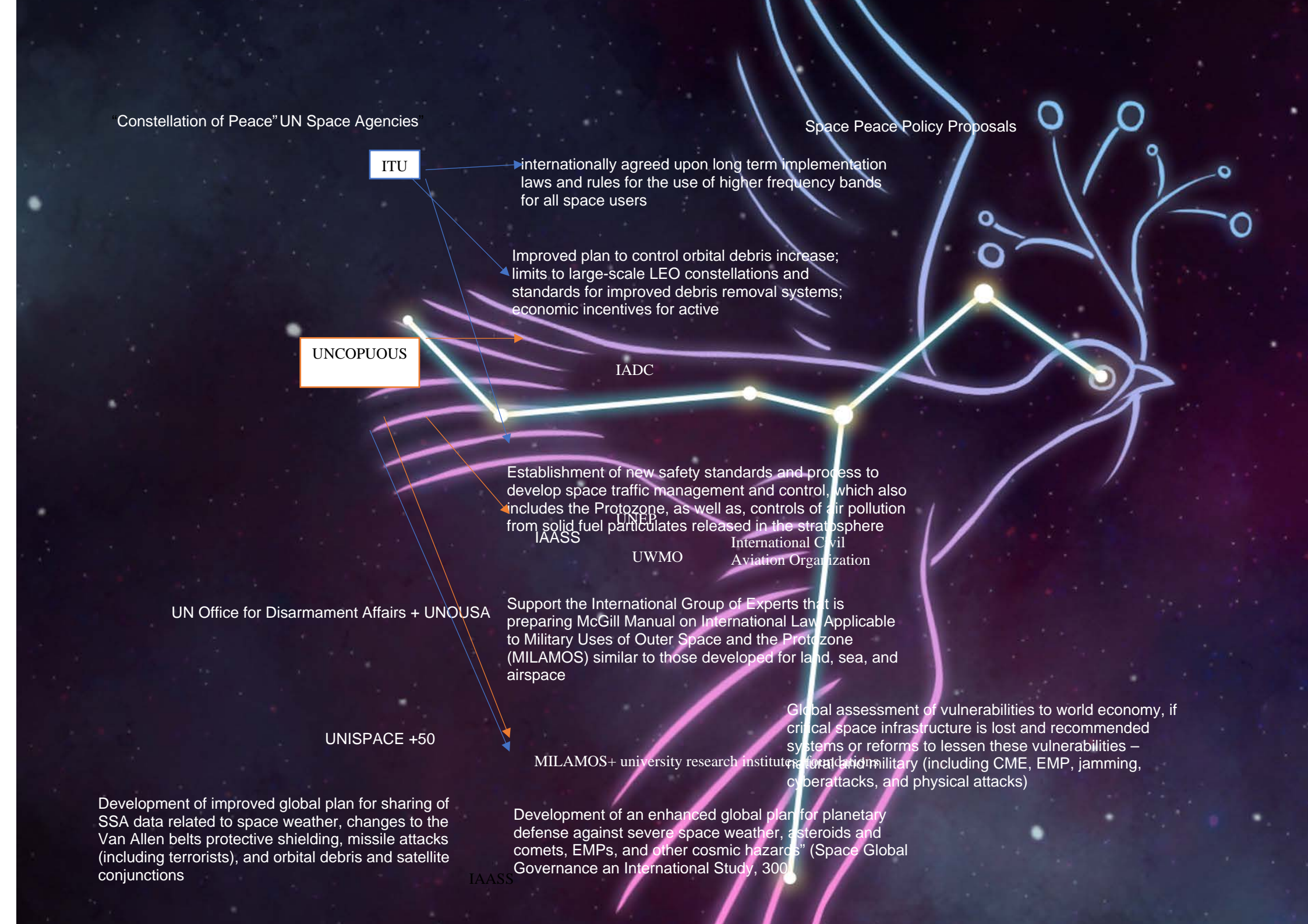

Global assessment of vulnerabilities to world economy, if critical space infrastructure is lost and recommended systems or reforms to lessen these vulnerabilities –
MILAMOS+ university research institutes and foundations
International military (including CME, EMP, jamming, cyberattacks, and physical attacks)

Development of improved global plan for sharing of SSA data related to space weather, changes to the Van Allen belts protective shielding, missile attacks (including terrorists), and orbital debris and satellite conjunctions

IAASS

Development of an enhanced global plan for planetary defense against severe space weather, asteroids and comets, EMPs, and other cosmic hazards” (Space Global Governance an International Study, 300)
