Al is a clinical academic dietitian. For over 20 years he has worked at the largest Dietetics Department in Europe, Guy's and St. Thomas' Hospital in London, leading on HIV care, obesity and bariatric surgery, and diabetes. He was awarded a Clinical Research Fellowship from the National Institute for Health Research to investigate prevention of type 2 diabetes in people living with HIV.
