COVID-19: Supporting Parents, Adolescents
and Children during Epidemics

Are you a parent or carer of a child who is in school Grade R – Grade 12 and lives in South Africa?

Stellenbosch University in partnership with the University of Oxford and the South African Association of Child & Adolescent Psychiatrists and Allied Professions (SA-ACAPAP) is doing a research project on children and adolescents' mental health throughout the COVID-19 crisis. The aim of this research is to find out how the responses and actions of parents over this time can protect children and teenagers from poor mental health, as well as to learn more about the qualities of the child and the family.
