

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Definitions

K.I.T. Group APAC Pte. Ltd. is the Professional Conference Organiser (PCO) appointed for the 44th International Conference on Halogenated Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), to be held 29th September – 4th October, 2024 in Singapore. The Conference organiser leads the Conference Secretariat and is responsible for registration services, hotel accommodation, speaker management, sponsorship opportunities, exhibition management and social events and is hereafter referred to as K.I.T. Group.

K.I.T Group is the administrative organiser of the Conference and the Conference Secretariat (staff and technical infrastructure) is provided by K.I.T. Group.

General Terms and Conditions for Registration

These General Terms and Conditions are valid for each attendee registered for the 9th International Conference on the 44th International Conference on Halogenated Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), to be held 29th September – 4th October, 2024 in Singapore (hereinafter referred to as the "Conference"). Any registered person, delegate, student, speaker or exhibitor is considered an attendee.

Conference Registration

The registration deadlines are as follows:

Only fully completed registration forms will be accepted. The registration fee is based on the date of the receipt of the registration form or completed online registration as well as the payment in full in accordance with the deadlines mentioned above.

The online registration can be completed by clicking the button "submit" which can be found at the end of the form.

Should one deadline be missed, the next applicable fee will be charged automatically. The registration will only be confirmed upon receipt of payment in full.

If the maximum attendee capacity is reached, the organisers reserve the right to refuse any registration.

Only registered attendees will be permitted access to the Conference.

To be eligible to register for the Conference, attendees must be at least 18 years old. Attendees may be asked to present an official identity card stating their age.

*To register as a student/Postdoctoral Researcher, proof of eligibility (copy of student ID or official letter from the university) is required confirming that you are a student at the time of registration and for the duration of the Conference.

**Exhibitor pass can only be purchased by Conference official exhibitor.

All proofs must be uploaded directly during the registration process.

Registration for Media is only via invitation.

Registrations for more than ten persons will be handled separately as a group booking. Please contact the Dioxin 2024 Registration Team at dioxin-registration@kit-group.org. Should the pre-paid amount not be used in full during the pre-registration process, the remaining amount can be used for on-site registration. There will be no refund for badges which are paid for, but not used (according to the deadlines mentioned above).

Only fully completed group registration forms as well as fully completed name lists (including the participants full name, individual email and postal address) will be accepted. The Dioxin 2024 Registration Team cannot be held responsible for double bookings of an individual participant or group made by another company or organisation.

Methods of Payment

Payment is required at the time of registration. It should be made in SGD only, using one of the following methods:

- 1. Online Payment via Stripe payment gateway: Attendees should complete the relevant section of the online registration form.
- 2. Bank transfer: Payment is only possible until 10 September, 2024 (2 weeks before the standard deadline) and should be made in SGD to:

Please note that <u>ALL</u> transfer costs must be prepaid by the transmitter.

Cheques will not be accepted.

Letter of Confirmation/Payment Receipt

A letter of confirmation/payment receipt will be sent by email once the K.I.T. Group Registration Department has received the fully completed registration



form and the related payment. Attendees must present this confirmation/payment receipt at the registration counter as proof of their registration and payment.

Letter of Invitation

Individuals requiring an official Letter of Invitation can be applied on Dioxin 2024 Website at https://dioxin2024.org/Data/List/Invitation-Letter.

The Letter of Invitation does not financially obligate the Conference organisers or any of their related partners in any way. All expenses incurred in relation to the Conference are the sole responsibility of the attendee.

Visa Requirements

It is the sole responsibility of the attendee to take care of his/her visa requirements. Attendees who require an entry visa must allow sufficient time for the application procedure. Attendees should contact the nearest embassy or consulate to determine the appropriate timing of their visa applications.

The organisers will not directly contact embassies and consulates on behalf of visa applicants.

In the event that a visa application is unsuccessful, but was applied for in due time, the registration fee, minus a handling fee of 50 SGD can be refunded. To receive the refund, the official proof from the embassy confirming that a visa could not be granted, must be sent to the Dioxin 2024 Registration Team no later than 25 September, 2024.

Registration Name Change

A handling fee of 50 SGD will be charged for every name change to an existing Conference registration. A new registration form for the substitute attendee should be submitted, as well as a proof for the reduced fee if applicable. Name changes will only be accepted until the standard registration deadline indicating clearly the new and old name. After the standard registration deadline, all name changes must be carried out on-site.

Lost Name Badge

The name badge must be worn at all times during the Conference. Access to the Conference facilities will not be granted without a proper name badge. If an attendee loses, misplaces or forgets the name badge, a handling fee of 20 SGD will be charged for a new name badge. Upon handing out a new name badge, the lost badge will become invalid.

Registration Cancellation Policy

Notification of cancellation must be made in writing and sent to the K.I.T. Group Registration Department by email. The notification must include all the relevant



information regarding the bank account to which a possible refund may be remitted.

In the event of cancellation of the registration up to and including 31 July 2024 (the date of receipt of the cancellation notification is decisive), a processing fee in the amount of 50 SGD of the respective fee will be charged.

In case of cancellation of the registration after 31 July 2024, a processing fee in the full amount of the respective fee concerned will be charged; in these cases a refund is excluded.

In case of payment by bank transfer, the notification of cancellation must include the bank details for a possible refund of the registration fee. All bank charges will be charged to delegates.

Same applies for cancellation of additional orders.

Refund requests will be processed after the Conference only. They must be made in writing and sent to the Dioxin 2024 Registration Team by email no later than 20 September, 2024. No refund request will be processed after this date.

Credit will not be given for unattended events or early termination of attendance.

Modification of the Conference Programme

The Conference organisers reserve the right to modify the programme, which is published as an indication only.

Cancellation of the Conference, Force Majeure

In the event that the Conference cannot be held or is postponed or the Conference organiser is prevented from carrying out its obligations as it pertains to the Conference as a result of any cause or due to events beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of God, strikes, labour disputes, government requisitions or advisory, restrictions or regulations on travel, hotel or facility availability, commodities or supplies, war or apparent act of war, terrorism, disaster of natural or man-made cause, civil disorder, diseases, epidemic or pandemic, curtailment or restriction on transportation facilities, or any other comparable calamity, casualty or condition (collectively a "Force Majeure") or due to events which are not attributable to wrongful intent or gross negligence of the Conference organisers, the Conference organiser shall have the right to cancel the Conference immediately and/or terminate the affected Conference without any liability and shall be relieved of its obligations to Attendee. In addition, if the Conference is terminated due to or as a result of a Force Majeure occurrence, the Conference organisers cannot be held liable by attendees for any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodation costs, financial losses, lost profits etc. Under these circumstances, the Conference organisers reserve the right to either retain the



entire registration fee and to use it for a future or rescheduled Conference, or to reimburse the attendee after deducting costs already incurred for the organisation of the Conference and which could not be recovered from third parties.

Processing and Data Protection of Credit Card Details

When you register you will be asked to complete the online form providing your full name, address, email address and telephone number. The above collected information is required to process, book and complete your booking (including the sending of a confirmation email of the booking to you).

Should you choose to make the payment for your bookings with credit card, your credit card details (i.e. credit card type and number, CVC code, expiration date, credit card holder name) will also be collected.

All data will be saved and processed in compliance with the applicable data protection legislation.

Furthermore, security procedures and technical and physical restrictions for accessing and using personal information have been implemented and are in full operation. Only authorized personnel is permitted to access personal information for performing their duties in respect of the requested services.

Sharing and Data Protection of Contact Details

The processing of all personal data (which includes acquisition, handling, utilization saving of data, changes, transmission, blocking and erasing) is executed by the Conference Secretariat within the applicable guidelines of the effective European General Data Protection Regulation.

The Conference Secretariat will collect and store all data for the preparation and execution of the the 9th International Conference on Metal-Organic Frameworks and Open Framework Compounds (Dioxin 2024). In addition, K.I.T Group and its subsidiaries periodically share contact details of attendees with third parties (e.g. industry companies) that may use these details to contact attendees regarding activities at the Conference or other communications which may be of interest. Therefore, data might be passed on to third parties (e.g. industry companies) unless otherwise explicitly indicated by the attendee.

As some Conference exhibitors and/or satellite holders may use the Lead Capture Technology, attendees can use their name badge like a business card with them to communicate their complete contact details. In this case you decide to whom you provide your data. Please note that offering your badge to be scanned at an exhibition stand and/or at the entrance to a satellite Conference implies your acceptance that the respective company receives your complete contact details from the organisers and may contact you, using the data.
