Terms of use

Registered participants are prohibited from sharing their conference login details with any third party. You may not publish or post other people's private information (such as identifying features, such as home phone number and address) without their express authorization and permission.

Registered participants agree that they will not interfere with the proper working of the Conference, nor use the conference platform:

- For any illegal purpose and cybercrime.
- Be in conflict with any applicable law, cybersecurity ordinance, rule, or regulation of any governmental authority.
- In conflict with any applicable data security and protection laws.

Participants further agree to adhere to the principles and values of the conference as outlined above. In practice, this means that as a registered conference participant:-

- You may not threaten violence against an individual or a group of people. We also prohibit the glorification of violence.
- You may not promote violence against, threaten or harass other people on the basis of race, ethnicity, national origin, caste, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, religious affiliation, age, physical or intellectual disability, profession, or disease.
- You may not publish or post other people's private information (such as identifying features, such as home phone number and address) without their express authorization and permission.
- You may not threaten or promote terrorism or violent extremism.
- You may not engage in the targeted harassment of someone or incite other people to do so. This includes expressing a wish or hope that someone experiences physical and/or mental harm.

- You may not impersonate any other person or entity or submit any false, defamatory, offensive, harassing material or any material that violates another party's rights of privacy and publicity.
- You may not publish offensive, untrue or illegal material.
- You may not submit unsolicited bulk or commercial messages ("spam") to users. Any unsolicited message must also not direct the recipient to any third-party site or other resources.
- You may not groom another individual and/or offer or solicit inappropriate behaviour through the conference platform.
