Prof. Philippe Lucien Pereira was appointed as Professor of Radiology at the Eberhard-Karls-University of Tübingen in 2001 and became Vice-Chairman of the Department in 2004.

Since 2008, he has been Head of the Center of Radiology, Minimally Invasive Therapies and Nuclear Medicine at SLK-Clinics, an Academic hospital of the Ruprecht-Karls-University of Heidelberg, and is a Professor of Radiology affiliated with the University of Tübingen, as well as with the Danube Private University in Austria.

Prof. Pereira acts in the Executive Committee of the German Society of Interventional Radiology (DeGIR) for oncological guidelines and Certification processes within the German Cancer Society.

Internationally, he has served on the Executive Committee of CIRSE since 2011 and now acts as Vice-President of the European Society of Interventional Radiology. After being President of IROS (Interventionell-Radiologisches Olbert Symposium) in 2018,

Prof. Pereira was Chairman of the European Congress of Interventional Oncology (ECIO 2022 and 2023). He is an Honorary Lecturer for several international Societies.

His research and clinical expertise have been published with more than 340 scientific publications and more than 40 book chapters as co-editor or co-author. He also takes a strong interest in biotechnology and medical engineering, being a consultant and actively participating in several Advisory Boards for further developments of innovative technologies and study concepts in interventional oncology.
