PROFESSOR EUGENE McNALLY

Professor McNally trained at University College Dublin, Northwick Park and the Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital Stanmore. His main clinical interests are the diagnosis and treatment of sports injuries, the early diagnosis of joint disease and musculoskeletal ultrasound. Professor McNally has held visiting Professorships to several countries including Australia on four occasions, North America and Japan. He teaches on the European Erasmus and ESMRMB School of MRI programs, has been an invited speaker over the last 20 years to the British, European and International Skeletal Societies and keynote speaker at the RSNA on two occasions. He has published over 100 articles and abstracts in the medical literature and 20 book chapters. He is author of the textbook 'Practical Musculoskeletal Ultrasound' which is in its second edition.

Professor McNally was a member of the organisation committee for imaging at London 2012 Olympic Games. He is a member of the European and International Skeletal Societies where he has held various committee positions including a founder member of the ultrasound committee, the sports imaging and rheumatology committees. Professor McNally is a past President of both the European and British Societies of Skeletal Radiology and the inaugural Royal College and BSSR Professor of MSK Radiology.
