Dr McCarthy did her medical training at the University of Cape Town and completed her radiology training in Oxford. She undertook a fellowship in musculoskeletal radiology at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre in Oxford where she currently works as a specialist Musculoskeletal Radiologist. She is regional Radiology Lead for the sarcoma, rheumatology and foot & ankle clinical-radiological services. Dr McCarthy has been the supervisor for Oxford's musculoskeletal radiology training program for over 10 years.

She is on the faculty of many educational courses and was involved in the integrated training initiative of the Royal College of Radiologists. Dr McCarthy has published widely in international peer reviewed journals and written several book chapters in the field of musculoskeletal radiology. She is regularly invited to lecture at national and international conferences and to peer review articles for a number of journals. Dr McCarthy is a member of the South African, British, European and International Skeletal Societies and sits on the European subcommittees for musculoskeletal ultrasound and tumours.
