Dr Sofocleous is a professor of interventional radiology at Weill-Cornell Medical College. He practices interventional oncology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Centre in New York City.

Dr Sofocleous serves as the International Councillor and a member of the Executive Council of the Society of Interventional Radiology. He focuses on image-guided treatment of metastatic colorectal disease in the liver and lungs.

He is an author of over 200 scientific papers, and he has delivered over 300 invited lectures in the field of interventional oncology. He is the lead investigator in clinical trials of thermal ablation and radioembolization of colorectal hepatic metastases.
