Robert Dixon, MD, FSIR is a professor in the Department of Radiology at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.

After completing his residency in Radiology at the State University of New York, Upstate Medical Center, and his fellowship in Interventional Radiology at the University of North Carolina, he joined the faculty at UNC from 2004 – 2021.

He served as the Residency Program Director for 10 years while at UNC and currently serves as the Program Director for Rad-Aid, Kenya.

His areas of interest include medical education, global health, prostate artery embolization, complex IVC filter removals, vertebral augmentation, oncologic interventions, hepatobiliary interventions, and radiation safety.

After facilitating the initiation of the UNC RAD-AID Chapter, he went on to assist with the creation of an Interventional Radiology Fellowship at the University of Nairobi in 2020.
