Darren Klass is a clinical professor of radiology at VGH and UBC hospitals in Vancouver and a consultant radiologist at the Cleveland Clinic in London, UK.

He obtained his medical degree from the University of Pretoria in South Africa and completed his registrar training at the Norwich Radiology Academy, before completing a fellowship in interventional radiology at UBC.

He obtained a doctorate from the University of East Anglia, researching the effects of direct and alternating current for tissue ablation.

He is the interventional radiology lead for the complex thoracic aortic stent graft programme at Vancouver General Hospital. He is the head of MRI for Vancouver Acute and developed the vascular MRI service at Vancouver General Hospital.

His clinical interests include interventional oncology, particularly locoregional therapies in the liver and advanced aortic therapies for aortic dissection.

He is currently involved in developing a clinical pathway for Holmium166 therapy in Vancouver.
