Eb Kader is a Private practice and part time state service diagnostic and Neuro/General Interventionalist. He qualified as a diagnostic radiologist in the early noughties garnering the Rhone-Polenc Medal for Diagnostic Radiology, as well as Protea Holdings prize for top Radiologist in SA.

Eb completed his Msc from University Paris-Sud in 2004.
