Dr Osman Ahmed is currently an Associate Professor in the section of Vascular and Interventional Radiology at the University of Chicago. He completed medical training at the University of Illinois College of Medicine before attending the University of Chicago for a Diagnostic Radiology residency. He subsequently completed his VIR fellowship at Stanford in 2015.

Dr Ahmed has been recognized as a leader in the community of IR, having been selected to attend the SIR's leadership and development academy and the 2020 recipient of the Gary Becker Young Investigator Award.
