Dr Shaygi is a full time Consultant Diagnostic and Interventional Radiologist working across several NHS hospitals including academic university, tertiary referral and major trauma centres in London, United Kingdom.

He has a busy role, performing and interpreting multi-modality diagnostic imaging (CT/MRI/ultrasound scan). His general interventional radiology commitments at London's largest tertiary referral centres and regional vascular units include a wide variety of planned and emergency endovascular and percutaneous procedures. His scientific and clinical interests are also focused on global health and making interventional radiology (IR) accessible to a broader population around the world including developing a new model for the introduction of IR in low-income countries.

Dr Shaygi has a background in surgical training and gained membership of The Royal College of Surgeons in 2009. During his surgical training, he was awarded a master's degree in Surgical Technology at Imperial College with a dissertation on designing and validating innovative surgical simulators.

He then began his general radiology training in Peninsula Radiology Academy in Devon, UK, which is the only purpose-built radiology academy in the world. Dr Shaygi became a Fellow of the Royal College of Radiologists and was awarded a funded CIRSE Interventional Fellowship in Dublin, Republic of Ireland. He further advanced his sub specialist experience with a fellowship at the University of Alberta, Canada training in interventional oncology. He subsequently gained the European Board of Interventional Radiology (EBIR) in 2019.

Dr Shaygi has developed a clinical and research interest in higher academic education in medicine and hyper-minimally invasive radiological interventions and image guided surgery of cancer. He is a keen clinical teacher and Fellow at the Higher Education Academy (FHEA) and has a formal academic position at Imperial College School of Medicine.
