Adam Waldman is Chair of Neuroradiology at Edinburgh University and Visiting Professor at Imperial College London.

He gained a PhD and undertook post-doctoral research in biophysics before training in medicine at Cambridge, then in Internal medicine followed by Radiology and Neuroradiology in London.

He was previously Consultant Neuroradiologist and Research Director for Radiology at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust. Adam has previously held the Royal College of Radiologists Roentgen Professorship and medal and has been the British Society of Neuroradiologists Academic Chair and du Boulay Travelling Professor.

His main research interests are in quantitative and physiological neuroimaging, and he leads experimental and translational imaging programmes in neuroinflammatory and neurodegenerative disease and neuro-oncology.
