

Presenter Guidelines

All rooms are equipped with a comfort monitor and lectern.

Preparing your presentation

Presentation format: Please refer to the <u>online programme</u> for your allocated time slot. Please ensure you allocate the time fairly to all presenters and allow time for questions.

Slide Size - PowerPoint presentations should use a 'Widescreen (16:9)' format for optimal display at the event (go to Design tab then Slide Size. On the dropdown menu, select 'Widescreen (16:9)'.

Please note, to ensure there is no delay between presentations you will **not** be able to use your own laptop for your presentation.

Submitting your presentation

Please send your presentation in the original format (not PDF) to <u>npapn@kc-jones.co.uk</u> by **Monday 2 September 2024** so we can upload all PowerPoint presentations to ensure there are no technical issues on the day. If you have film or video clips embedded in your presentation, please also supply any film or video as separate files in .WMV, .MOV or .MP4 formats.

Quick tip: Please make sure you save your presentation in a file with <u>your name</u> as the title and your session (1.1, 2.1 etc.).

Copyrighted footage - If film clips that feature copyrighted footage (such as commercial TV productions/adverts, or feature commercial music) are to be used, then the appropriate permissions from the copyright holders should be provided to enable the clips to be played and prevent falling foul or the Performing Rights Society (PRS) and Mechanical Copyright Protection Society (MCPS).

A speaker-ready room will be available for you at P&J Live TECA, in order for you to check your presentation slides.

You may also want to bring handouts with your details and a summary of your presentation to give to interested delegates after your talk. Unfortunately, the organisers are unable to print anything for you.

Delivering your presentation

Please ensure you arrive to your presenting room in plenty of time.

At the end of your session please make sure you take all your materials with you and leave the room ready for the next presenters.

Sharing your presentation after the Conference

Please note that all presentations will be shared as a PDF, through a download link, after the conference automatically. If you do **not** want your presentation to be shared in this way, please state this to the organisers when you send your presentation.
