CCTV

Surveillance cameras are provided in certain areas as a deterrent to crime. This has been strategically assessed as per the CCTV policy. (Public Areas, Hotel Room Passages, Entrances, Back of House)

Guest Room Provisions

- External electronic door locks which can be double-locked from the inside
- Secondary locking night latch device for entry and connecting door locks
- Self-closing door closer on entry door
- Spy-hole in the door
- In-room Electronic Safes

First Aid

The hotel has qualified first aiders on duty 24/7. We provide this facility for both team members, guests, and members of the public. First aid requisites are checked regularly. The hotel has an automated external defibrillator (AED) and it is located at the Reception Area

Bomb Blanket

The hotel has a Bomb Blanket back of house, should there be a need to cover a suspicious device or package

Fire Prevention

- The hotel complies with the requirements of local fire safety enforcement laws
- Fire drills involving all team members are conducted at least semi-annually
- The fire alarm system includes automatic detection and audible alarms
- Team members trained in fire evacuation procedures are on duty 24/7
- Mandatory checks relating to fire alarm system, fire detection, emergency lighting and portable firefighting equipment are in place
- The Fire assembly point is at The Splash parking with Alternative Point at Fountain.

Fire action

Any person discovering a fire

Sound the alarm by pressing the nearest break glass call point.


Employees may attack the fire if possible using the appliances provided.

On hearing the fire alarm

Leave building by nearest fire exit route.

Close all doors behind you.

Report to fire assembly point at hotel main entrance.

Workplace Safety

This hotel arranges for periodic internal inspections to ensure hazards are identified and removed or control measures implemented. Risk assessments are in place and guide safety mitigation strategies

Inspections and Support

Periodic inspections undertaken to support safety and general welfare conditions. The aim is to confirm compliance with local and national legislation within the country of operation. The inspections confirm compliance or highlight hazards requiring attention. Reports are presented to management and findings actioned

Control of Hazardous Substances

The supply and use of substances in hotels are controlled as part of our environmental policy as is the provision of personal protective equipment

Supervision of Gym and Swimming Pool

This issue is recognised, and clear signage outlines the Hotel's specific safety procedures

Emergency Procedures and Incident Control

The hotel has procedures covering a wide variety of crisis situations. These procedures cover such items as fire, bomb threat, chemical spillage, guest illness, viral outbreaks, food contamination, hostage etc

Emergency Power

The hotel has a generator that will activate about 10 seconds after power down and emergency back-up designated lighting and power to key systems and equipment

Engineering Safety Inspections

Periodic inspections or maintenance on specific items of equipment are scheduled and maintained

Water Hygiene

- Water hygiene assessments and regular sampling carried out
- A system of water temperature monitoring and showerhead cleaning is in place

Electrical Safety

Periodic electrical inspections are carried out

Human Resources / Team Members

- Safety and security training within the hotel are carried out as part of the induction program
- Team members are encouraged to raise suggestions for improvements or safety concerns with their elected representative or line manager
- Team members recognize the importance of working in a safe manner as identified through the induction and departmental training received
