In 2007 was working at the World Health Organization, Geneva as intern at IVR Malaria Vaccine Initiative. He has participated in the design, implementation and analysis of several clinical trials, including evaluation of intermittent treatment in infants, and the evaluation of malaria vaccine in Mozambique. 2008/09 he was Chair of the Clinical Trials Partnership Committee CTPC. In 2011 was a member of the Initiative to Strengthen Health Research Capacity in Africa (ISHReCA) Steering Committee. From 2011 is member of the National Advisor Committee on Immunization, Currently is the Chair of National Commission for Polio Eradication in Mozambique, Vice Chair of the INDEPTH network between 2011 and 2014. Currently Member of SAGE COVID 19 vaccine working group and Vice chair PAG Program Advisor Group for MVIP (Malaria Vaccine Implementation Programme).
