

Kwadwo Asamoah Kusi is a Senior Research Fellow in Immunology at NMIMR. His research is on pathogen-induced immune responses, especially against *Plasmodium*. He works on multi-allele vaccine formulation strategies that aim to overcome the strain-dependent effects of antigen polymorphisms on immune responses and on finding pathogen peptides that elicit protection-associated T cell responses in malaria-infected persons. He also has on-going work on HBV/malaria co-infections and their joint effect on liver health and is lead immunologist on clinical trials at NMIMR.
