Tamsin is a Consultant Urological Surgeon and Honorary Associate Professor at University College London (Hospitals). She runs a large multidisciplinary Functional, Reconstructive and Adolescent (FRA) Urology service, with her main interests being urinary tract fistulae, female urethral diverticulum, male and female urethral stricture, complex male and female urinary incontinence, mesh complication surgery and lower urinary tract reconstruction.

She has been Chair of the BAUS section of Functional, Neurourology and Urodynamics, BAUS Director of Education and the RCS (Eng) Urology Tutor. She is currently; a member of the AUA's GURS Board of Directors, the EAU's ESGURS committee, the EAU Urethral Stricture Guidelines Committee, the Vice Chair of the UKCS and the Chair of the EAU Taskforce on EDI. She was awarded the John Anderson Medal by BAUS for outstanding contribution to British urology in 2020. She has over 150 published papers and book chapter – and a similar number of shoes!
