Abstract

Rapid Urbanisation all over the world is throwing various challenge for policy makers, planners and local governments. With more than half of the world population living in towns and cities, it has become a common place statement to say that we live in an urban world. Not only are cities growing, but they are producing more and more of the world's wealth. As a consequence, urban inequality is becoming more widespread, with measures of inequality growing most rapidly in cities with lower income levels. There is disparity in access to basic amenities in cities.
