Abstract

In this special session, several topics about regional development under the new wave of globalization and current introverted economic policies are discussed. Especially, studies about economic effects of 45th U.S. President Trump's trade war with China on Japan's trade, about the effective factors to attract more international conferences to a Japan's region, about the effects of regional trade agreements on multilateral trade agreements when member countries eliminate tariffs and use mutual recognition on product standards, and about the economic and environmental effects caused by agri-tourism promotion and international migration in a developed country with free trade and capital mobility are included in this session.
