- Entry is free but must be submitted to Fitwise electronically by Friday midday, three weeks prior to the event. It is the responsibility of the company to ensure that the entry has been received by this time. Any entry received after the deadline will not be considered.
- Judging will take place prior to the Conference and will be undertaken by an experienced panel that will include a range of bladder and bowel specialist practitioners. The judges' decision is final.
- Submissions must be made on the form below and must not exceed the word limit. Companies may also submit a video demonstrating the use of the innovation, if they wish. The video must not exceed three minutes in length.
