With the earliest meetings stretching back to 1952, the Society was founded in 1968, with the objective of improving the oral health of children in the UK. Throughout its history, the BSPD has campaigned for improving standards in child dental health, implementing improvements in children's oral health, including the current "Dental Check by One" campaign.
