The 'ACP Industry Innovation Award' is awarded by the ACP and is for new innovations only.

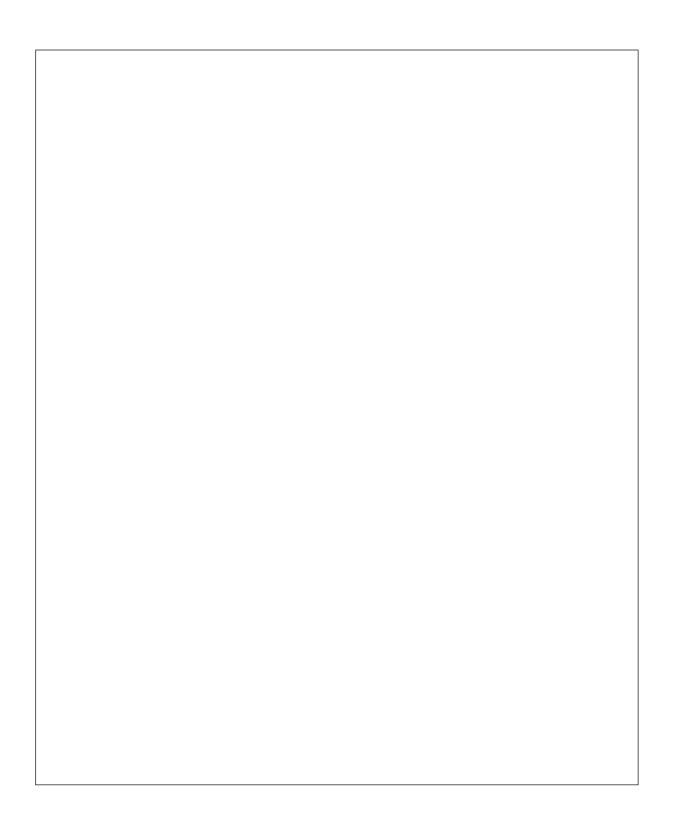
- Entry is open to any company exhibiting at this year's ACP Conference, that has launched a new continence related product/innovation since the last ACP Conference
