## **GUIDELINES FOR THE POSTER SESSION**

- Dimensions of each poster should be 80 cm (width) x 100 cm (height) mounted vertically.
- We will be sending a separate email to upload the pdf version of the poster for the congress app.
- The first author of the poster abstract is responsible for the proper assembly, mounting, and presentation of his/her poster.
- The board surface consists of fabric and only hook Velcro can be used to affix onto them. The congress organizers will provide hook Velcro for display.
- At the top of each poster, you should post a label stating the title, authors, and author affiliations and logos of Institution /University.
- The official language at the Poster Session will be English.
- Illustrations and texts must be read from a distance of at least one-and-a-half meters away. The poster should be understandable without oral explanation. All lines should be heavily drawn.
- The poster should contain an introduction, methodology, results with illustrations (such as figures, tables) discussion and conclusions/recommendations.
- It is helpful to bring handouts of your poster, as well as your business cards, to pass on to those who are interested.

## NOTES:

- If circumstances prevent the submitter from being present, s/he must arrange for a substitute to present the poster, a co-author of the poster. Presenters are expected to discuss their work (3 minutes presentation followed by 2 minutes questions) with scientists visiting their poster display, particularly during the coffee breaks of the Conference.
- It is advisable to check the invited speakers list and the program prior to the Conference so you may be able to contact the speaker in your relevant field via congress app and invite them to visit your poster and discuss your results.
