We'll help you achieve your green goals by incorporating equipment that requires the least amount of power, such as LED lighting, which uses six times less power per unit than other lighting options. We also offer post-consumer recycled flipchart paper, whiteboards and other sustainable meeting supplies.

Energy Star Compliance

Encore makes every effort to purchase Energy Star-compliant equipment, which is the most environmentally responsible technology available. Additionally, we seek Restriction of Hazardous Substances-compliant products, which are manufactured with the use of minimally hazardous materials.

Generally, modern technology offers greater energy savings, so Encore continually evaluates equipment, including lifespan, Energy Star compliance, and power consumption to introduce more efficient options. We encourage our customers to source their equipment and technicians locally to avoid the environmental impact from shipping and long-distance traveling.

Sustainability – Encore & DGRADE

- Plastic takes hundreds, if not thousands of years to decompose in landfill. 95% of all plastic ever created is still in existence today. Plastic can cause major environmental damage and harm animals when not disposed of properly.
- Encore Middle East has now entered an innovative collaboration with DGrade, converting its PET waste into high-quality yarn for textiles.
- Kris Barber, Director at DGRADE that produces sustainable clothing using Greenspun yarn
 made from recycled plastic bottles, has also been a vocal advocate of the importance to go
 green. The UAE's first bottle-to-yarn manufacturing company focused on making clothes out
 of plastic, initiated the 'Simply Bottles' campaign offering organisations a platform to collect
 plastic bottles and convert them into t-shirts, trousers, shorts, jackets, towels and caps.

Impact of Plastic on the Environment

Plastic bottles are made from oil, oil is a finite resource and will not last forever.

50% of camel deaths in the UAE are due to plastic ingestion. Less than 6% of plastic is recycled in the UAE, which means 94% of plastic goes to landfill.

PET is the easiest plastic to recycle and the most recycled type of plastic.

PET Plastic water bottles are hygienic and resealable making them convenient and easy to carry.

More than 4 billion plastic water bottles are produced every year in the UAE.

Less than 6% of plastic is recycled in the UAE




Social Values


