

GOVERNANCE

Compromise of stakeholders and sectorial policies and responsibilities to ensure that **objectives**, **policies** and actions are aligned and consider all possible aspects.

Development and systematic implementation of integrated procedures to inter-connect and conciliate different interests.

WILDFIRE PREVENTION AS A
TRANSVERSAL ASPECT IN SECTORIAL
PLANNING POLICIES

FORESTRY AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT

Adaptive and aligned forest management and rural development policies for resilient and resistant landscapes.

Develop of accurate and updated fuel maps, including all fuel components are needed as a basis to plan fire resilient and resistant landscapes fires. **Identification of priority areas for action**, based on risk analysis and scientific evidence.
