Privacy Policy for Administration of NIVAS Membership and Conference Registration

Privacy

- We keep to a minimum the information we hold about you
- We use your data to provide the NIVAS membership and NIVAS delegate services to you
- We only use a limited amount of Cookies to help us manage your membership
- We delete your data when it is no longer needed for these things
- We do not give your information to third parties we have not informed you of
- You have lots of privacy rights (See below for more details)
- We take security seriously
- We do not record calls
- We are happy to chat to you about how we process and protect your data

Who are we?

Media 1 Productions is a trading name of the <u>Media 1 Productions Ltd</u> and we are a Production, AV and meetings and events company who act on behalf of "NIVAS", the National Infusion and Vascular Access Society for the management of your membership and meeting registrations.

We collect and process your personal information to administer your annual membership and attendance at NIVAS meetings. You will receive a reminder email for renewal at the end of the calendar month of which your membership expires.

Our Registration Site is separate to the <u>NIVAS website</u> which is managed by REVA.

What data we hold?

We will hold the following information about you:

- Data provided by you, including your name, address, email address
- Information about your specific interest areas
- Information in communications that you have sent to us
- If you are an invoiced customer, we will hold financial payment details including billing address

It is also important to point out that any cookies used do not identify you personally.

Using Your Information

We have to tell you what our lawful basis is for processing your data. Please see below.

Processing your data for purposes of administering your membership

We use the information we hold about you to give you the best service we can.

The legal basis for processing this data is for the performance of a contract and is necessary to deliver the service to you, to administer your membership and provide you with membership benefits such as relevant publications and information in the interest areas you told us about, and to process your registrations for meetings.

If you have given your consent, we will send you details of meetings and events in any interest area you have told us about and relevant details of NIVAS.

Your data and the EEA

We do not transfer or process data outside the European Economic Area unless we have your specific consent or where the nature of the processing requires it.

Whenever we transfer your personal data out of the EEA, we ensure a similar degree of protection is afforded to it by ensuring at least one of the following safeguards is implemented:

- We will only transfer your personal data to countries that have been deemed to provide an adequate level of protection for personal data by the European Commission.
- We may use specific contracts approved by the European Commission which give personal data the same protection it has in Europe.
- Where we use providers based in the US, we may transfer data to them if they are part of the Privacy Shield which requires them to provide similar protection to personal data shared between the Europe and the US

Retention periods

We will process personal data for the duration of your membership and keep it for a period of 1 year thereafter, unless you ask us to delete it before this time. We do this so we can process your membership and give data to the NIVAS Committee as part of membership services.

Third parties

As a general principle, we will not transfer your personal data to third parties without your permission, but to process your membership we need to share with the following:

- 1. We share your information with the <u>National Infusion and Vascular Access Society</u>
- 2. We share your information with REVA, who manage the NIVAS website
- 3. We share your information with the Mark Allen Support Group, who send the *British Journal of Nursing* to NIVAS members
- 4. We share your information with Centium Software who provide the EventsAIR software to process your membership
- 5. We share your information with Data Cash to securely process credit or debit card payments you may make
- 6. We share your information with Mailchimp and Survey Monkey to send you emails and manage responses

We also have a small number of companies providing services to us. We use telephony services, which would get to see your phone number if we call you to respond to an enquiry, and a broadband supplier which could see your email address (but not the content of what you send us).

Your rights

You have lots of rights in respect of our processing of your personal data. The relevant rights are:

- Request a copy of your personal data and information about our processing of it
- Request that we delete information on you if we do not need to hold it
- Request that we correct any personal data that we hold on you
- Request that we stop processing your data, although we can still hold it
- Request that we move your data to another organisation's IT system electronically
- To withdraw any consents you have given us to process your data

Technical security
