Essential Christian requests all Exhibitors to agree to the following terms and conditions when exhibiting online at Spring Harvest.

Applications

Applications must be received by **Friday 19th March 2021**.

Participation

Essential Christian will review applications to ensure the organisation reflects the aims, objectives, and ethos of our event.

Spring Harvest agrees with the Evangelical Alliance Basis of Faith and Lausanne Covenant and reserves the right to ask for items to be removed from your landing page that could cause offense or are not considered appropriate.

1. SH Home 21 – Online Virtual exhibition packages

30 virtual exhibition spaces are available at £300 plus VAT. These are available on a 'first-come – first served' basis. Thereafter the cost will increase to £350 plus VAT.

The first 30 'visits' to your stand are included in the costs above, thereafter each visit will be invoiced post event at £0.10 Essential Christian will be using Google Analytics to track these visits.

2. Payment

The full amount becomes due upon approval of your application and our terms of payment is 28 days.

Invoices for additional 'visits' will be sent week commencing 19th April, our terms of payment are 28 days.

3. VAT

Standard VAT rate of 20% is applicable.

4. Cancellations

If you wish to cancel your exhibition package, please do so by email to the Exhibition Manager, Nikki Green nikki.green@eem.solutions. Essential Christian reserve the right to retain 50% of the monies paid.

5. Online Activities

We would request that additional activities including, but not limited to, surveys or questionnaires are approved by Essential Christian, in writing, prior to the event start date, 4th April.

All articles, goods, advertisements any other material associated with your online presence must comply with the law and be free from any offensive or defamatory images, words, or statements. They must not infringe copyright, trademark, design, patent, or other intellectual property right and must conform to any statutory provisions or regulations. Essential Christian reserve the right to ask you to remove immediately anything that we deem inappropriate, unsuitable or which may cause offence to delegates.

6. Restrictions

Unless Essential Christian have granted prior written authorisation, you or any of your staff will not sell, assign, rent, transfer, trade or share any part of the Spring Harvest 2021 exhibition package with any other organisation

7. Opening Times

The Exhibition Hub will be open 24/7 for the duration of the event. Live main sessions will take place between 10-11.30am and 7-9pm and the Exhibition Hub will be promoted during these sessions.

Between the hours of 11am-3pm and 8.30-10pm, it is compulsory for representatives of your organisation to be available in live chat and video calling to engage with attendees. Your availability outside of these times is entirely at your discretion.

8. Event publicity

Upon confirmation of your 2021 exhibition package, you consent to Essential Christian and agencies authorised by us to use, reproduce your image, and that of your stand for publicity purposes in the UK and abroad.

9. Partner organisations

Essential Christian may work with partner organisations to deliver certain aspects of the Spring Harvest event and exhibition. By exhibiting, you agree to us passing your details to these partner organisations who will only use this information in relation to Spring Harvest. You will not be contacted for any other purpose.

10. Event passes

You will be able to access the Exhibition Hub independently of the SH Home 21 Event. If you wish to register and participate in the programme, we are offering anyone registered as an exhibition team member 50% discount. Discount codes will be provided once your application has been approved.

11. Dispute

In all matters of dispute at the Exhibition, in the first instance you should put your complaint, in writing, setting out the circumstances in full to Nikki Green. Your complaint will be carefully considered, and you will receive a written decision. If you are dissatisfied with this response, you should refer the matter to the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators for mediator or arbitration.

12. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This agreement and any disputes arising out of or in connection with its subject matter are governed and construed in accordance with the law of England. The parties to the agreement hereby irrevocably agreed that the Courts of England have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this agreement.

If any provision of this agreement (or any part of any provision) is found by a court or other authority or competent jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that provision or part provision shall, to the extent required, be deemed not to form part of this agreement and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this agreement shall not be affected.
