- ✓ AGE > 18 YEARS

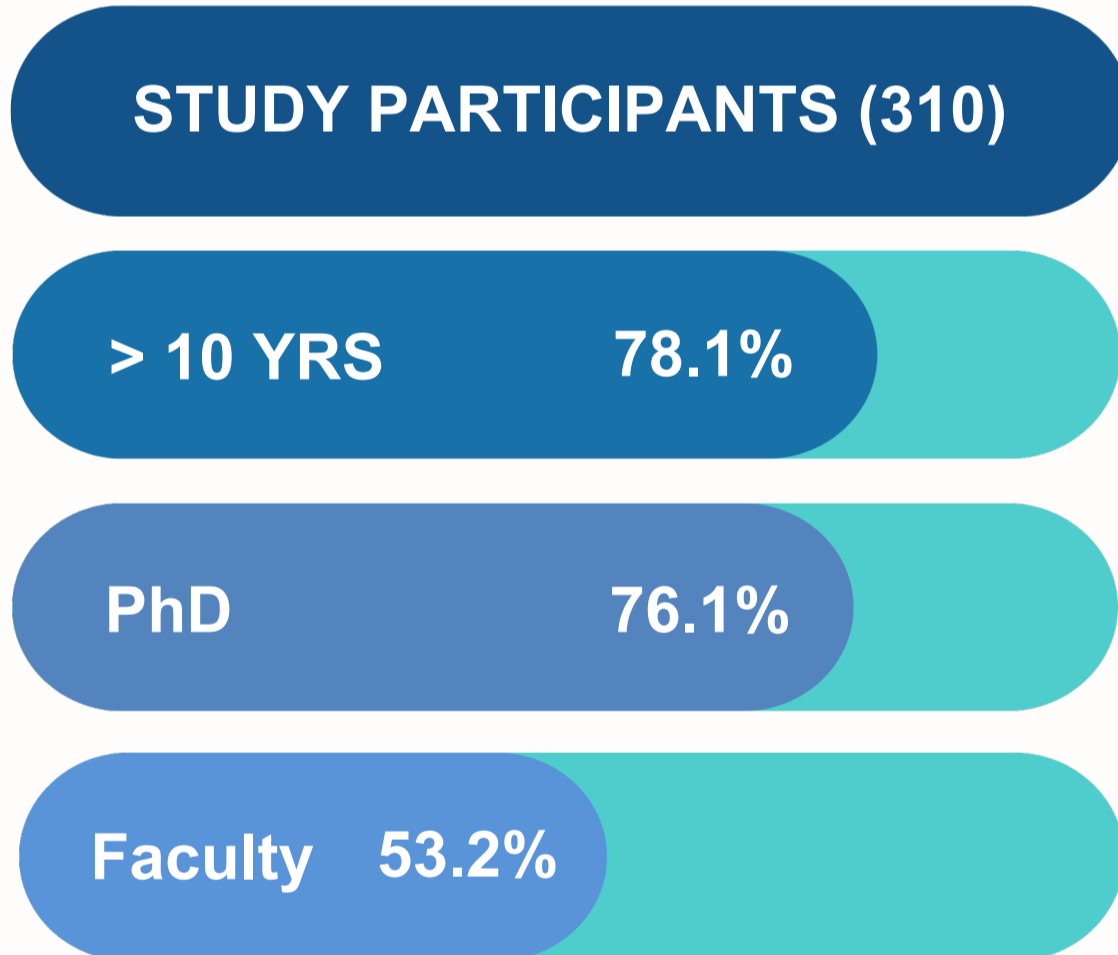
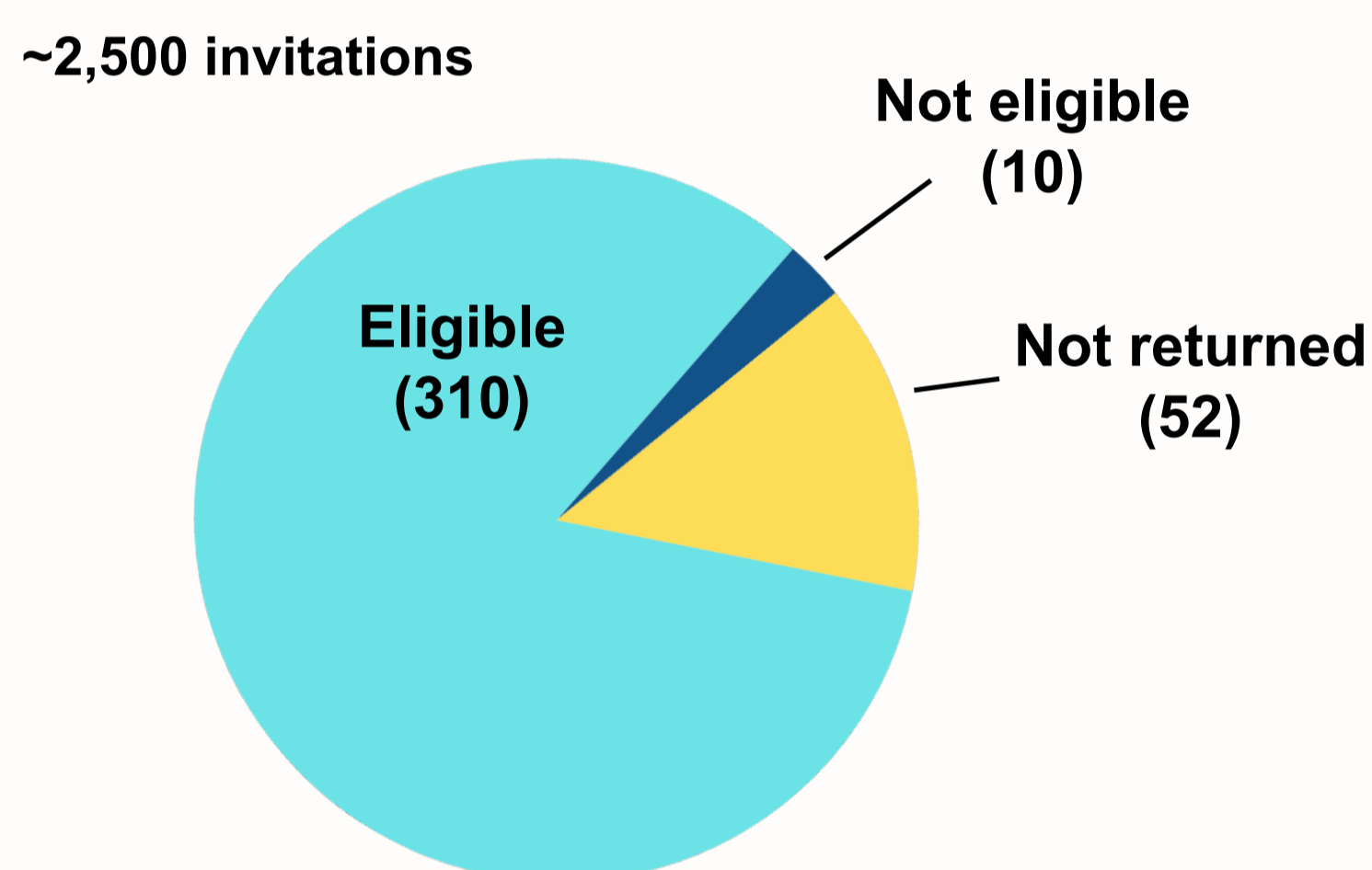

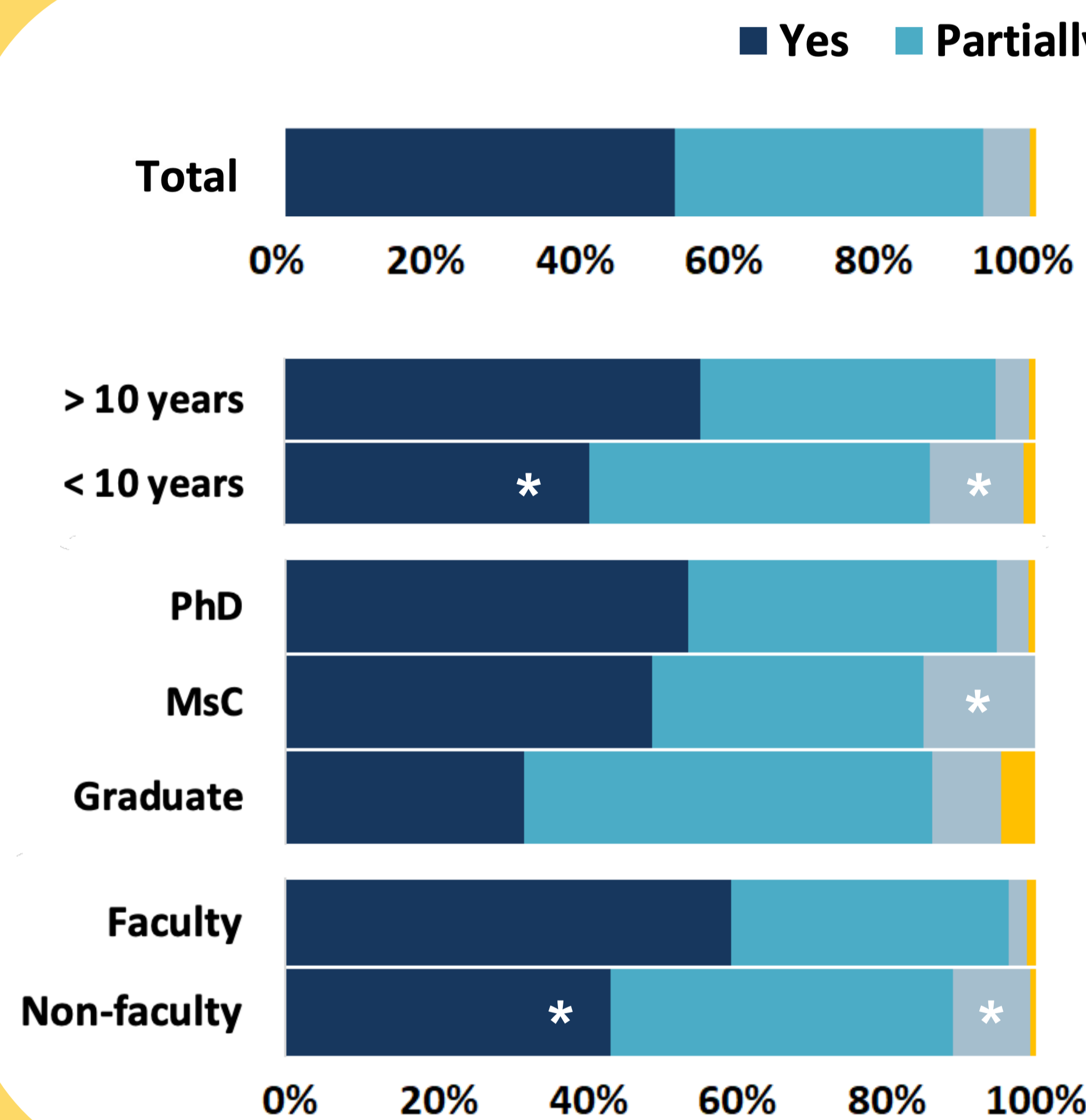
To assess the perception of Research Integrity among researchers at Fiocruz.

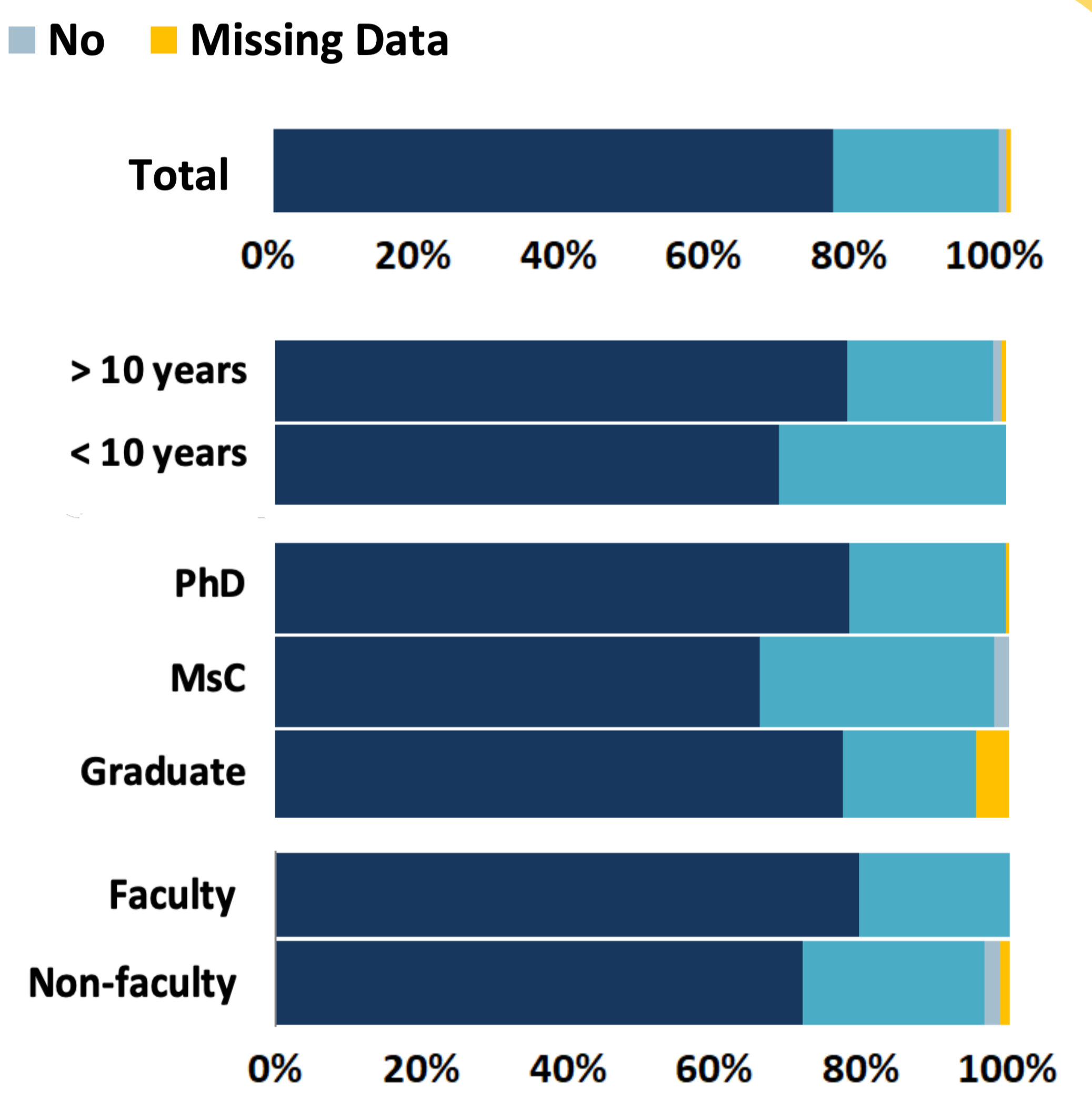

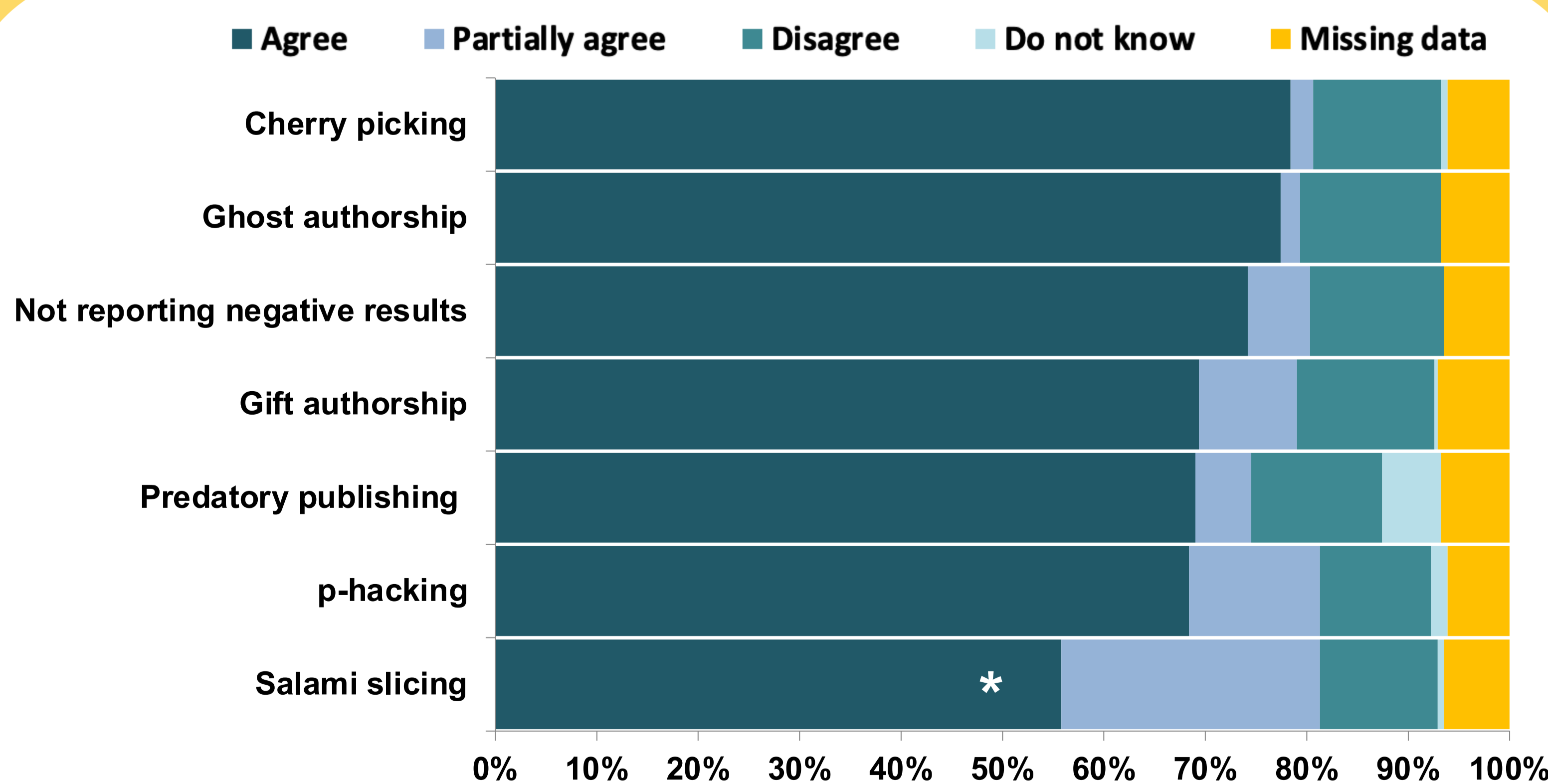
Are you familiar with RI?



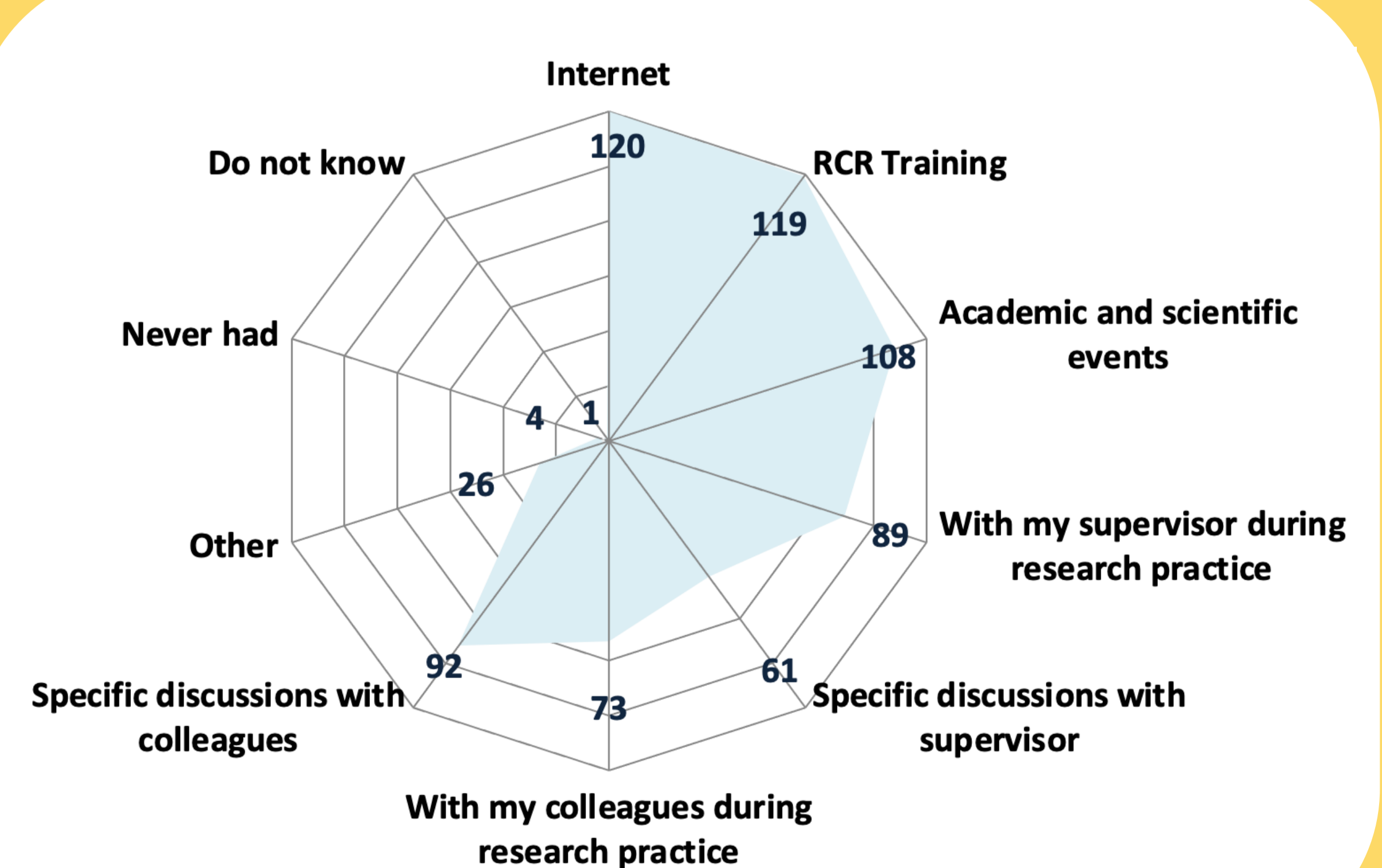
Do you know the definition of research misconduct (FFP)?
