

What changed?

New University wide inter-disciplinary Research Ethics Committees (RECs)

New digital system and coordination of ethics review processes

New central team to provide guidance, training, advice on policies, processes and strategy

Opportunities for **improved ethics literacy**: guidance, portal, open house, ownership of the system

Anticipation of and response to **new challenges**: AI, social media, geo-politics, etc



What stayed the same?

The requirement to uphold the **highest standards** of research integrity for all **research STAFF and STUDENTS**

The requirement to seek **Committee-level review** for any application involving **humans**, their data/tissue or animals


