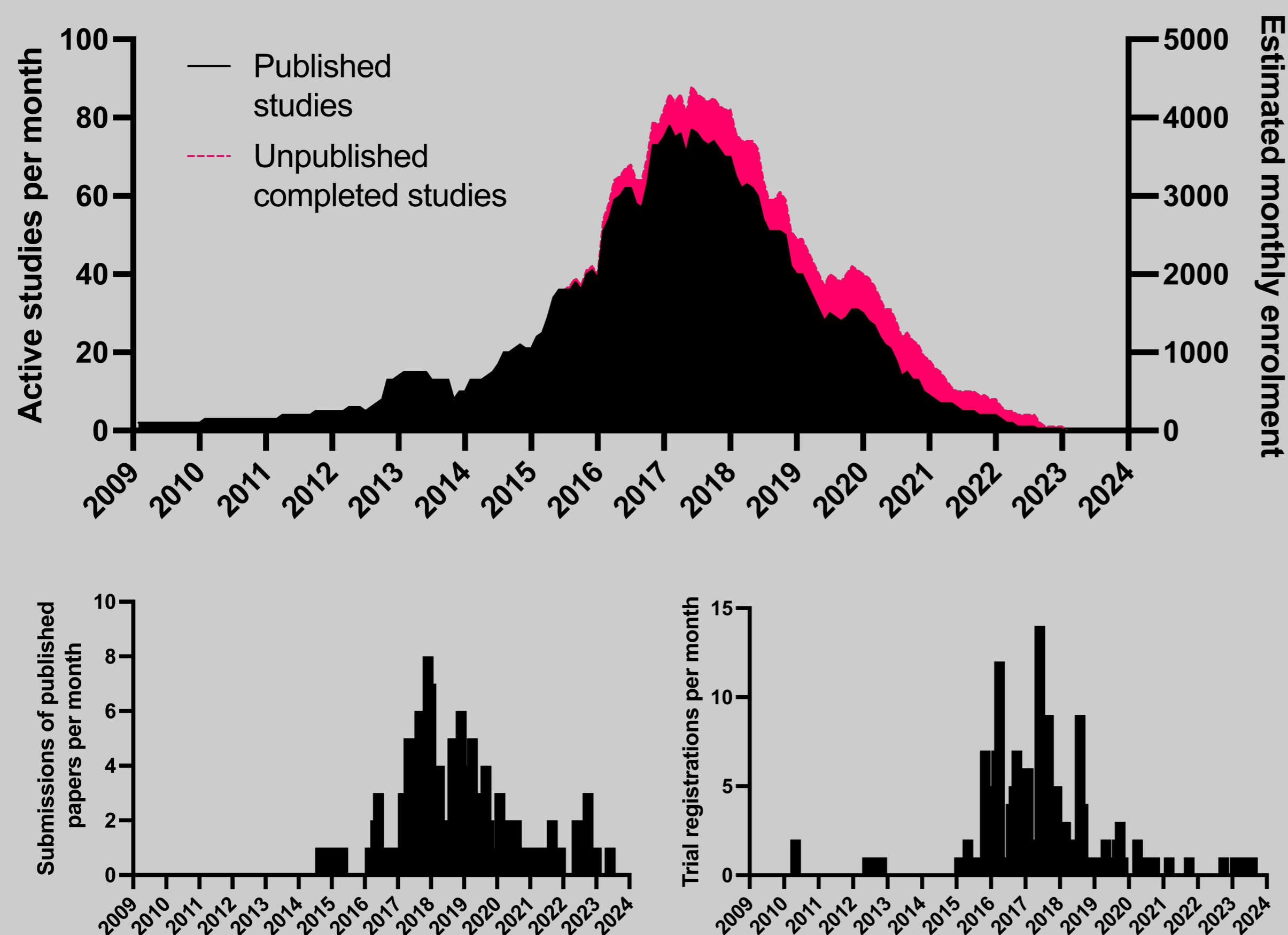


Concerns about data integrity across 263 papers by one author

Dr. Abbas is highly prolific



Background

Dr. A.M. Abbas, Assistant Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of Assiut, Egypt, is an author of **eight retracted papers**.

Methods

We identified all published and ongoing prospective clinical studies by Dr. Abbas.

We individually assessed all papers, plotted study timelines, and checked consistency between all existing records of published studies.

Results

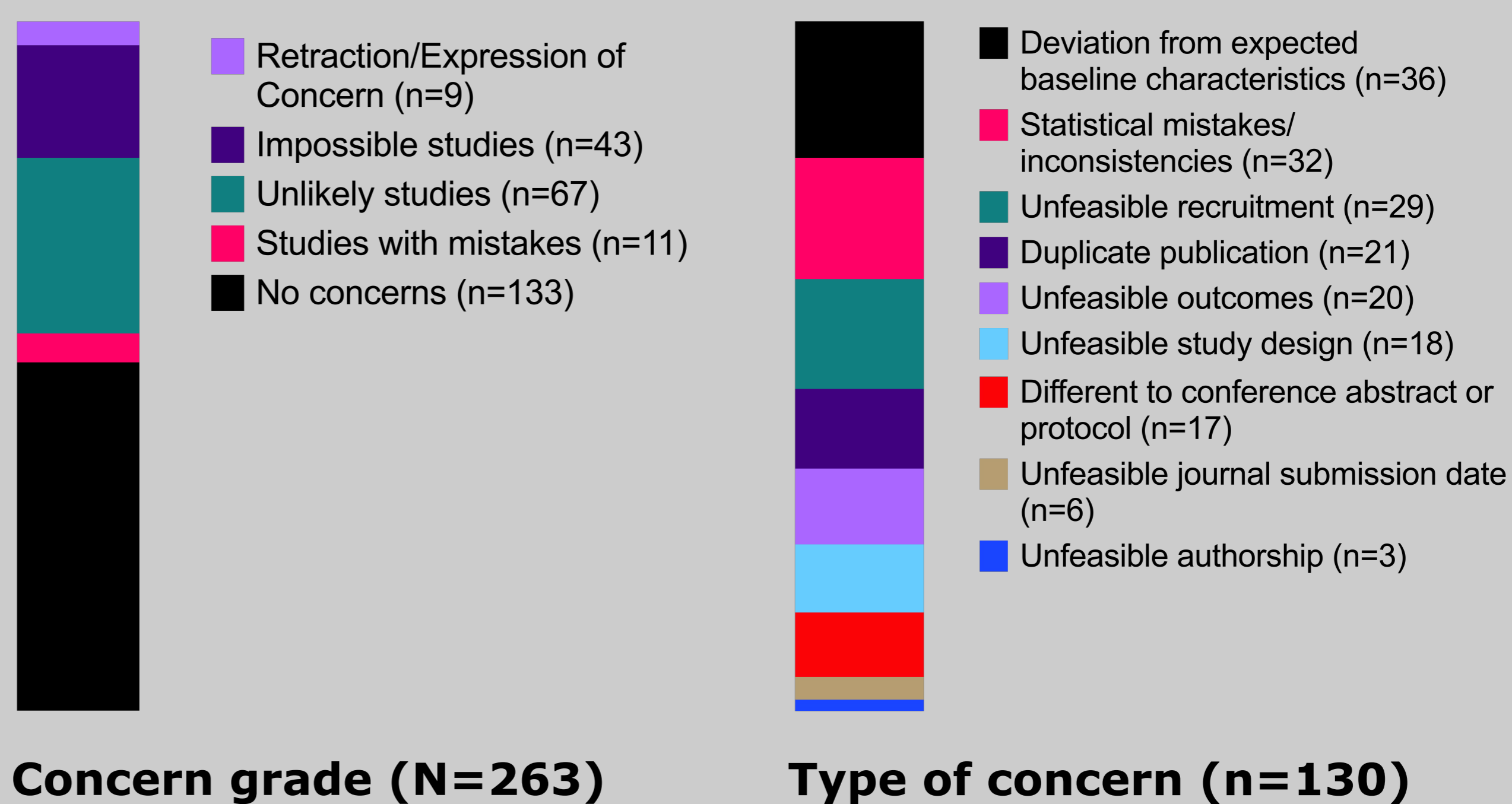
263 papers and **74,667 participants** between January 2009 and July 2022.

Dr. Abbas claimed to conduct up to **88 clinical studies simultaneously**.

190 (**72%**) studies recruited partially or entirely from the Assiut Women's Health Hospital.

Dr. Abbas was first author of 60 (23%) papers.

Individual assessment revealed 130 papers with integrity concerns
