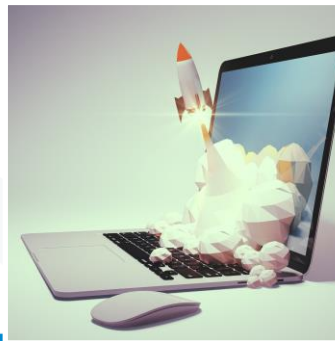
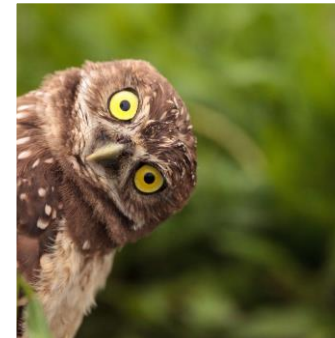


Academic dishonesty in an online world




Academic dishonesty may be more prevalent in online classes (Holden et al., 2020)

Mixed findings on whether online environments lead to higher instances of cheating compared to traditional classrooms (Beck, 2014; Black et al., 2019).



The ease of cheating in online exams and the challenges in maintaining academic integrity in remote assessment settings (Nguyen et al., 2022; Kohen-Vacs et al., 2021).

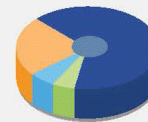

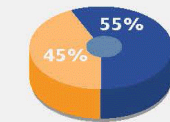

RACE



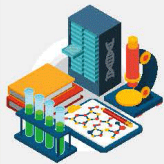
● African **77%**

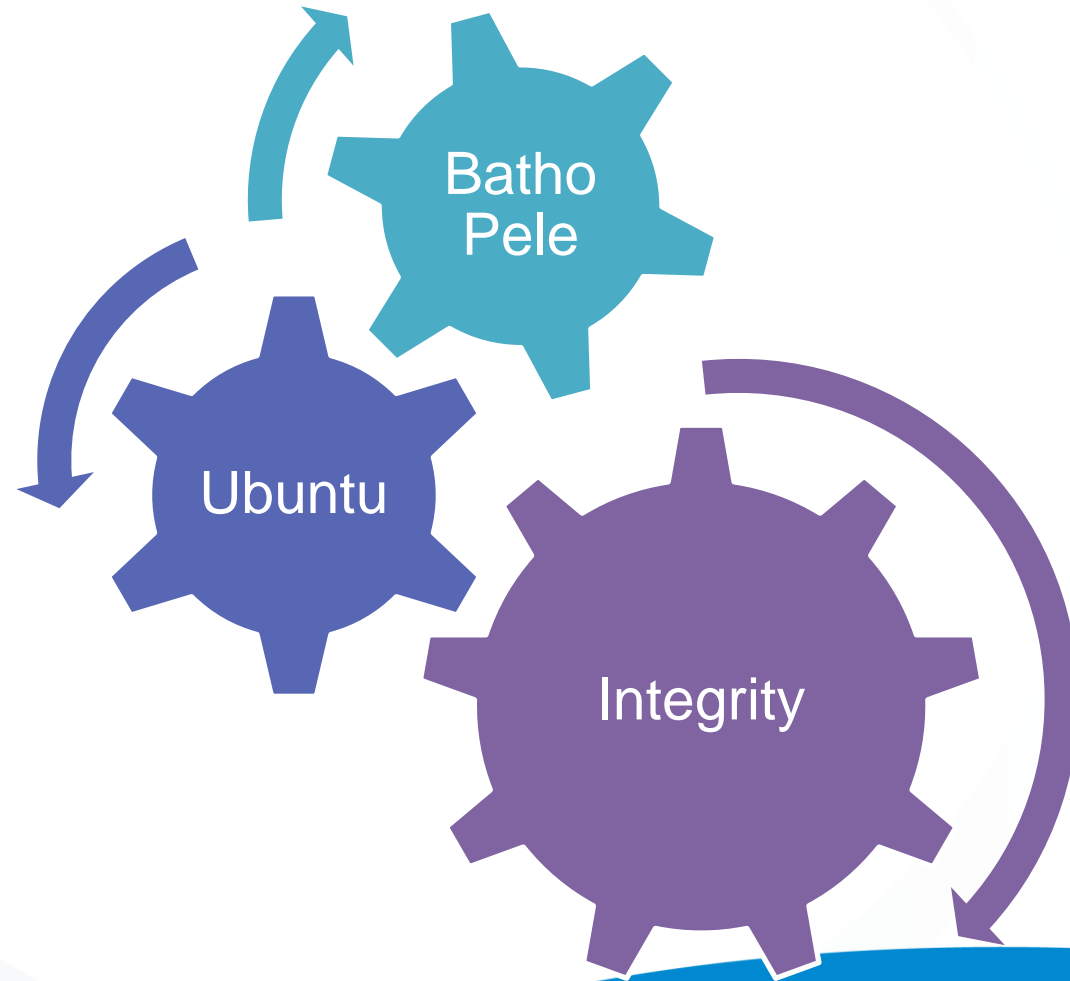
