A HOLISTIC APPROACH TO GOOD SCIENTIFIC PRACTICE

The Barcelona Biomedical Research Park (PRBB) hosts six research institutions dedicated to study life from DNA and molecules to whole populations. Since its creation, research integrity has been a core value at the park and its centres, with a holistic approach currently consisting of the following elements:

1.CODE OF GOOD SCIENTIFIC PRACTICE

 Common to all six centres of the park

 Created in 2000; updated in 2023 and aligned with the European ALLEA Code.

2.RESEARCH INTEGRITY TRAINING

 Science in Action, since 1998 a compulsory course for PhD students in biomedicine at UPF (>160/year)



4.WELLBEING

- Social activities (yoga, choir, orchestra)
- Training (stress and time management, mindfulness, peer mentoring, emotional intelligence or resilience)
- Anti-harassment policies, psychological and medical support at the centres

3.GSP WORKING GROUP

- Share learning and good practice in scientific integrity; independent support for PRBB institutes in cases of serious misconduct
- Catalyse the development of crossinstitute initiatives on e.g. research assessment, supervision, authorship or research culture.
