

SGBV Requirements in UN-Coordinated Inter-Agency Humanitarian Plans

The SGBV requirements in UN-coordinated inter-agency response plans have been calculated in different ways, depending on in-country mechanisms for calculating overall response plan requirements. In some countries, a stand-alone SGBV sub-sector has been created, while in others, projects addressing SGBV prevention and response are included under the Protection, Health and WASH clusters and tagged as SGBV. In a number of countries, customized costing methodology is used to express requirements for clusters, thus SGBV requirements have been estimated based by the SGBV incountry coordinators (UNFPA). In the regional and country refugee response plans coordinated by UNHCR, overall requirements are multi-sector and SGBV requirements have been estimated by UNHCR.

The estimated requirements of \$661.5 million detailed below, are the minimum financial resources needed in 2019 for SGBV prevention and response programming in humanitarian contexts and are subject to change as needs evolve throughout the year.

Humanitarian partners are encouraged to report all humanitarian funding for SGBV to the Financial Tracking Service (FTS) at fts@un.org with sufficient details to allow improved tracking and identification of gaps and unmet needs.
