



Graham Louw is an Emeritus Professor of Anatomy at the University of Cape Town. He completed his undergraduate training as a veterinarian at the University of Pretoria, later also completing his Doctoral Degree in Developmental Neuro-embryology. Upon his return to Cape Town, he was appointed as a Senior Lecturer in the Faculty of Health Sciences (FHS) at the University of Cape Town (UCT) from 1989 until his retirement in 2019. During this time, he completed his Master of Philosophy in Higher Education Studies at UCT. His teaching at undergraduate and postgraduate levels and research have spanned the fields of Comparative Anatomy, Clinical Anatomy, Embryology, Neurosciences, Biological Anthropology and Medical Education. Until recently he was still teaching on a part-time basis at UCT, and is currently serving his third term as Chair of the FHS Animal Ethics Committee (AEC) as well as serving as Deputy Chair of the Senate AEC at UCT. He has served as both Honorary Treasurer and President on the ASSA Council.
