Having a presence at the conference will allow you the opportunity to connect with around 220-280 participants from across the world, but mainly from European countries, with both doctors, scientists and non-doctor medical practitioners working in a range of specialities from A&E, acute medicine, geriatric medicine, intensive care medicine, neurology, psychiatry, paediatrics, and anaesthetics.


EUROPEAN DELIRIUM ASSOCIATION
